## 2312 CLASS SIZE

The Superintendent shall recommend for Board approval the number of class sections for each course or grade level. Such recommendations shall take into consideration factors such as school enrollment, student needs, curriculum requirements, types of instructional setting, district finances and space or equipment limitations but not the location of the dwelling/domicile of the students. An elementary "wait list" for student placement shall be developed by the building administrators and implemented when a vacancy occurs at a school.

Low course selection of middle school and high school courses shall be reviewed by the Board for approval in the spring (prior to final scheduling).

The maximum recommended Kindergarten through grade five class size is twenty-five students when there are twenty-five students in the class who spend at least seventy-five percent of their time in that class for core subjects excluding art, music, physical education and health, and learning center activities.

Particular attention shall be paid to space-per-student requirements of the New Jersey State Department of Education.
