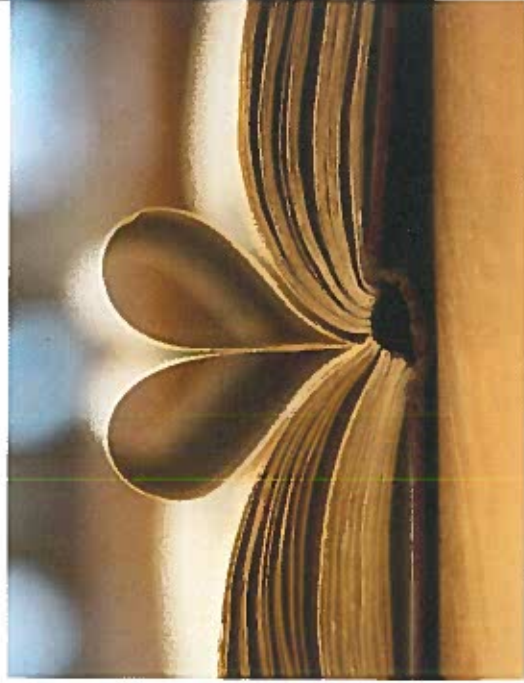


SEPAC:
